Computer Assisted Learning For ESL Students

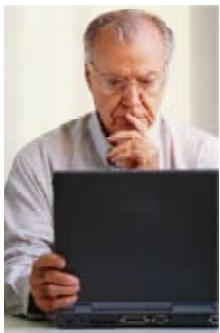

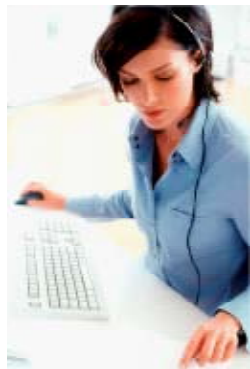
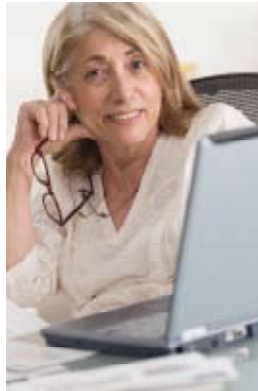
