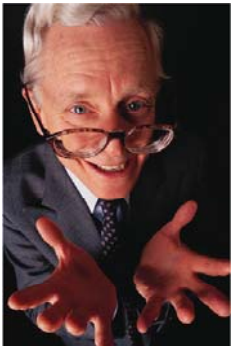


Personal Interest
